Primary level

In this stage, we focus on developing Early Literacy Skills, motor Coordination, thinking skills, positive self-concepts and independence. Preschool is about establishing social behaviours, and preparing children to learn and develop school readiness, to set them up for the rest of their academic path.

The primary curriculum offers children opportunities to develop in different ways by providing experience in analyzing and problem solving, research and investigation, independent work and real-life situations via educational excursions.

Secondary level

In lower secondary school, students are given access to a broad range of subjects so that they can experience different academic disciplines, develop their talents and learn more about their strengths.

Students will experience various types of knowledge in Expressive and Creative, Linguistic and Literacy, Mathematical, Physical and Recreational, Scientific, Human Social and Environmental studies.

The curriculum offered in Years 10 and 11 builds on the knowledge, skills and understandings gained in the lower years. Integration of varied subjects allows a greater degree of specialization.






